Feba UK is a Christian mission agency focused on the creative use of radio and other audio media to inspire people to follow Jesus Christ. We work with partners across Africa, Asia and the Middle East with a particular focus on contexts that are 'closed' or where it is difficult to be a Christian.

1 – 5 July: India

Our prayers this week focus on a project supported by Feba UK in northern India called *Portable Life Changers (PLC)*. Using speaker boxes, *PLC* reaches vulnerable people who have little or no contact with a local church. These individuals gather regularly in small community 'hubs' to listen to engaging Bible-based audio content that helps nurture faith, build fellowship and encourage spiritual growth.

Wednesday 1 July

ANSWERED PRAYER! Praise God that there are now over 900 *Portable Life Changers (PLC)* listener hubs, with many more people wanting to get involved. We thank God for opening doors for more hubs to be established, especially in communities where the gospel has not been heard before. Pray that many will welcome this unique opportunity to hear God's word and choose to follow Jesus. [Romans 10:17](#)

Thursday 2 July

Please pray for the *PLC* teams who travel to remote communities to support local hubs and update the audio content. Ask God to protect and encourage them, especially during this month's rainy season when journeys can be even more challenging. Pray that they would know His wisdom, peace and guidance in every situation. [Psalm 121:7-8](#)

Friday 3 July

Anya* is 35 and cannot read or write, but through her local *PLC* hub she is now able to listen to God's word in her own heart language. She is also growing in her faith and enjoying fellowship with other believers. Please pray for Anya and others like her as they hear about Jesus for the first time. Ask that God would guide them as they learn and take steps to follow Him each day. [John 8:31-32](#)

Saturday 4 July

Many people who attend the *PLC* hubs face the risk of being ostracised by friends and family simply for wanting to find out what it means to follow Jesus. Please pray that they would have the courage and strength to remain faithful in the midst of opposition and misunderstanding. Ask God to surround them with His peace, strengthen their faith and reassure them that He will never leave them. [Joshua 1:9](#)

Sunday 5 July

As the number of *PLC* hubs continues to grow, please pray that God would raise up more volunteers to support this ministry. Pray for men and women who are willing to travel, encourage listeners and help others learn more about Jesus. May their faithful service enable many more people to hear God's word and become His disciples in communities where there are few opportunities to hear the gospel. [Luke 10:2](#)

6 – 12 July: Kyrgyzstan

Our partner in Kyrgyzstan is reaching the country's 6.4 million people, most of whom are Muslim, with the good news of Jesus Christ. With six FM stations covering most of Kyrgyzstan and a vibrant online ministry, the team are sharing the gospel – often for the first time in people's native language. In a nation where many people have little opportunity to hear about Jesus, these broadcasts are helping people explore the Christian faith and discover more about Him.

Monday 6 July

ANSWERED PRAYER! Praise God that He is raising up a new generation of young Christians in Kyrgyzstan with a passion to serve in media ministry and share the good news of Jesus through digital platforms and new technology. Please pray that these young people will grow in faith and develop their skills to help expand our partner's outreach and bring the message of Christ to new audiences across Central Asia. [1 Peter 4:10](#)

Tuesday 7 July

The team in Kyrgyzstan shares that one of the greatest challenges facing their listeners is the fear of persecution for believing in Jesus. As a result, it is becoming increasingly difficult to find believers who are willing to speak openly on air because of the risk of persecution or social isolation. Please pray that God will give listeners the courage and confidence to share their faith and talk about the love and hope they have found in Jesus. [Acts 4:29](#)

Wednesday 8 July

Please pray for wisdom and discernment for the team as they seek ways to continue sharing the good news of Jesus within Kyrgyzstan's new laws, which restrict open evangelism and invitations to follow Christ. As government control over religious activity increases, pray for peace, stability and understanding between people of different faiths. Ask God to protect and strengthen evangelical Christians who may be particularly affected by the stricter regulations now in force. [Colossians 4:5-6](#)

Thursday 9 July

Many listeners experience intense pressure, domestic violence or persecution because of their faith, often from spouses or relatives. Please pray that God will surround them with His comfort and protection. Pray also for wisdom and discernment for our partner as they seek to identify those in urgent need of support and connect them with pastors, psychologists and legal assistance where appropriate. [Psalm 9:9](#)

Friday 10 July

By the end of 2027, our partner hopes to train up to 30 new bloggers and online broadcasters from local churches. The team is also planning an inter-church media conference to equip believers to use media, AI and new technologies

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for evangelism. Please pray that God will call and prepare the right people for this ministry, equipping them with the skills, wisdom and commitment needed to share the good news of Jesus with others. [2 Timothy 2:2](#)

Saturday 11 July

Following severe icy conditions in the mountains, the antenna tower serving one of our partners FM stations collapsed. Please pray for the team working to restore broadcasting as quickly as possible. Ask God to provide all that is needed to rebuild the tower and reconnect with listeners across the region. [Philippians 4:19](#)

Sunday 12 July

As Kyrgyzstan prepares for its upcoming presidential elections early next year, please pray for peace, wisdom and stability across the nation. With diverse political, cultural and religious influences shaping the region, ask God to guide those in positions of leadership and responsibility. Pray that the election process will be peaceful and just, and that the decisions made in the months ahead will be for the good of all the people of Kyrgyzstan. [1 Timothy 2:1-2](#)

13 – 19 July: Yemen

Feba's partner *The Yemen Project* is broadcasting the good news of Jesus into a nation where the ongoing humanitarian crisis continues to have a deep and traumatic effect on many Yemeni citizens. Alongside producing programmes that teach about the Christian faith, Feba's partner also shares practical advice to help listeners explore both social and spiritual transformation.

Monday 13 July

ANSWERED PRAYER! Praise God that listeners are engaging with the radio programmes and social media content produced by Feba's partners. The team is greatly encouraged by the testimonies of hope, healing and transformation from listeners who have heard the gospel. We also give thanks to God for providing the resources needed to sustain this ministry, particularly in challenging circumstances. Please pray that God will raise up gifted producers and content creators to help develop new programmes and reach even more people with the good news of Jesus. [Philippians 1:3-6](#)

Tuesday 14 July

Please pray for the team as they prepare for a period of change and transition. Pray that Aaron's* visa application for Egypt will be successful so that he can attend a forthcoming workshop. Please pray for project coordinator, John*, as he moves into a new role, and for the team as they adapt to these changes. We remember the production and follow-up team and ask God to guide them as they create relevant content and respond to listeners, ensuring that every programme, message and online conversation reflects His love and truth. [Psalm 32:8](#)

Wednesday 15 July

Please pray for the planning and preparation of this year's *Reality Church* recordings in Egypt. These programmes are designed to equip Yemeni believers to model and build Christian fellowship in their homes. *Reality Church* provides vital teaching and encouragement for those who are unable to gather openly for worship. Pray that the recordings will run smoothly and that the programmes will strengthen believers in their faith. Ask that they would encourage new expressions of Christian fellowship to grow across Yemen. [Hebrews 10:24-25](#)

Thursday 16 July

Saeed*, a friend of the ministry, has asked for prayer after heavy rain caused extensive damage to his home. Please pray that God will provide for Saeed and his family during this difficult time, giving them strength, encouragement and practical help as they begin to rebuild. Pray that they will know God's peace and care in the midst of these challenges. [Nahum 1:7](#)

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Friday 17 July

Please pray for the teams as they create programmes for a wide range of listeners, including women, young people, leaders and those living on the margins of society. Pray for God's wisdom and creativity as they develop content for each different audience, that it would touch people's hearts, speak into their daily lives, and help many to discover new life in Jesus. [John 10:10](#)

Saturday 18 July

Remember and pray for believers who remain in prison because of their faith in Jesus. Ask God to strengthen and encourage them. May they know God's Spirit filling them each day with His peace and the strength to remain faithful while experiencing suffering and injustice. Lift up their families too, asking that they would know God's comfort, provision and protection during this very challenging and uncertain time. [Hebrews 13:3](#)

Sunday 19 July

Please keep praying for peace and stability in Yemen as the devastating conflict continues. Remember those afflicted by poverty and displacement, asking God to provide for their needs and bring comfort in these hard times. Pray that nothing would hinder people from hearing programmes that share practical help, spiritual encouragement and the good news of Jesus. [2 Thessalonians 3:1](#)

20 – 31 July: Afghanistan

For the rest of this month, our prayers focus on Feba UK's new ministry partner, *Afghan Radio*. Through evangelistic and discipleship programmes, the team is sharing the good news of Jesus with Afghans both within Afghanistan and among the Afghan diaspora worldwide. They also provide follow-up support for listeners and equip believers to grow in their faith and share Christ with others in challenging circumstances.

Monday 20 July

ANSWERED PRAYER! Praise God that more families are listening to *Afghan Radio* programmes. Feedback from listeners shows that children are excited to learn – some say it feels like being at school. Give thanks that these programmes are helping to meet a real need in a country where access to education is limited for many, especially for girls. Pray that families will grow in their understanding of Jesus as they hear biblical teaching and receive daily spiritual encouragement. [John 6:45](#)

Tuesday 21 July

We give thanks for two new members of the *Afghan Radio* team who both speak the language used in the broadcasts. One is a radio monitor working within Afghanistan who helps ensure that programmes can be heard clearly across the region. The other is a discipleship mentor who encourages listeners to grow in their faith and become more like Jesus. Please pray that God will use both of these roles to strengthen the ministry and support those seeking to know Him better. [1 Corinthians 12:18](#)

Wednesday 22 July

With the Taliban government enforcing an extreme interpretation of Islam and Islamic law, many listeners live in fear that when they call *Afghan Radio*, their phone conversations may be monitored. Please pray that they will know God's protection and peace as they seek help, ask questions and explore the Christian faith. May they experience God's perfect love, which drives out fear, and find the courage to take the next step in their spiritual journey. [1 John 4:18](#)

Thursday 23 July

In some parts of Afghanistan, the local authorities attempt to interfere with *Afghan Radio*'s medium and shortwave broadcasts, making it more difficult for listeners to hear the programmes clearly. Please pray that these attempts to

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disrupt the broadcasts will be unsuccessful and that many people will still be able to hear the good news of Jesus. Pray too that God would work in the hearts of those in positions of authority and enable the team at *Afghan Radio* to continue sharing His message unhindered. [Acts 28:31](#)

Friday 24 July

Please pray for believers who are imprisoned in Afghanistan simply for following Jesus. Ask God to provide for their needs and to strengthen them as they put their hope and trust in Him each day. Pray that He will make a way for their release where there currently seems to be no way. Lift up their families too, asking God to surround them with His comfort and care through the support of fellow believers. [Isaiah 61:1](#)

Saturday 25 July

Many families are now listening regularly to *Afghan Radio* programmes together and joining with the team for Bible studies. Pray that these families will grow stronger in their faith, encouraging one another as they learn more about Jesus. As parents learn to trust God and take Him at His word, pray that their children will be encouraged to know and follow Jesus from an early age. [Deuteronomy 6:6-7](#)

Sunday 26 July

Plans are underway to provide radio training for the *Afghan Radio* team in Europe this autumn. Please pray for all those involved in the preparations and for everyone who will take part. As part of the practical training, there will be opportunities to record new programmes which will be broadcast later in the year. Pray that the team will be encouraged, equipped and strengthened for their ongoing ministry among Afghan listeners. [Proverbs 16:3](#)

Monday 27 July

Afghan Radio's discipleship and follow-up teams regularly speak with listeners who are exploring the Christian faith and asking important questions about Jesus. Please pray that the fruit of the Holy Spirit will be evident in every conversation, whether online or over the phone. May God give the team wisdom, compassion and patience as they encourage those who are seeking the truth. [1 Peter 3:15](#)

Tuesday 28 July

Afghan believers and seekers need safe ways to connect with the *Afghan Radio* team and take part in regular Bible studies. Please pray for wisdom as the team develops secure communication platforms that will allow people to ask questions, study God's word, and encourage one another without fear that their conversations may be monitored. [Proverbs 1:33](#)

Wednesday 29 July

Some Afghan families are having to follow Jesus in secret because of the risks of openly professing the Christian faith under the Taliban regime. Please pray that God will give them the courage and strength to remain faithful to Him. May they know His protection, peace, and guidance as they seek to honour Christ in their homes and daily lives. [Psalm 27:1](#)

Thursday 30 July

Please pray that God will continue to build His church in Afghanistan and among Afghan communities around the world. Give thanks for all those who are coming to faith in Jesus through the ministry of *Afghan Radio*. Pray that believers will be strengthened in their faith, encouraged in fellowship and equipped to share the hope they have found in Christ with others. [Matthew 16:18](#)

Friday 31 July

As we conclude our prayers for *Afghan Radio* this month, please pray for peace between Afghanistan and Pakistan. Relations between the two nations are tense and in June Pakistan launched deadly airstrikes along its border with Afghanistan. Pray for God's guidance for political leaders and those in positions of influence, that they would pursue wisdom, stability and understanding. Pray for all those affected by tension and uncertainty in the region, and that opportunities to share the good news of Jesus will continue despite the challenges and restrictions they face. [Psalm 29:11](#)
