1 – 6 September: Northeast Africa

Feba supports ministry among a predominantly Muslim people group in Northeast Africa. Many listeners have been forced to flee their homes because of years of civil war, leaving behind their communities and livelihoods. This week, we are praying for *Friend in a Wilderness (FiAW)* – a regular shortwave radio programme that shares the good news of Jesus in their heart language.

Tuesday 1 September

ANSWERED PRAYER! Praise God for His mercy and faithful provision, which enable the team to keep producing and broadcasting seven programmes each week on shortwave radio. We thank God for the team's creativity and passion as they explore fresh ways to share the gospel through short audio and video messages that connect directly with their listeners. [John 10:27](#)

Wednesday 2 September

Please pray for everyone serving the ministry of *FiAW* including the staff and volunteers. Ask God to sustain them, give them His peace in stressful situations, and protect the health and wellbeing of their families. Pray that God will give the team wisdom as they seek to bring the comfort and hope of the gospel to listeners facing hardship, particularly those living in refugee camps and those forced to serve in the army. Thursday 3 September

Please lift up in prayer the listeners who face regular threats and persecution for their faith. Most of the believers are unable to share their faith openly and risk opposition if others discover that they are followers of Jesus. Some also endure rejection and isolation simply because they listen to *FiAW*. Pray that God, who is faithful, will strengthen, protect and guide them as they seek to follow Him each day. [2 Thessalonians 3:3](#)

Friday 4 September

This region has endured many years of violent conflict and political instability. Please pray for lasting peace and reconciliation between different factions and countries in Northeast Africa. Recent reports suggest that security is worsening, with rumours of renewed fighting in some areas served by *FiAW*. [Isaiah 2:4](#)

Saturday 5 September

Remember in prayer the young people who have been forced to flee because of conflict and injustice in their country. Pray that, through the ministry of *FiAW*, they will continue to grow spiritually, remain strong in their faith, and follow Christ faithfully despite the many challenges they face each day. [1 Timothy 4:12](#)

Sunday 6 September

FiAW has listeners scattered across north Africa. Many have been forced to flee their homes because of violence and conflict. Today they face severe hardship and uncertainty, making it even harder for them to return home. Pray that God would heal their emotional, physical and spiritual wounds, and restore them with His peace and hope.

7 – 13 September: West Africa

Growing insecurity and the presence of jihadist groups have made life increasingly difficult for many people in this Muslim-majority country. Feba's partner, *The Good Shepherd Project*, is reaching a nomadic people group in their own language through local radio broadcasts. Two pastors and a producer are also travelling to build relationships, share the gospel, establish WhatsApp Bible study groups and encourage new believers.

Monday 7 September

We give thanks for two elderly men who recently met an evangelist from *The Good Shepherd Project*. After sharing Christ's love with them, he gave them SD cards with audio content that can be played on a mobile phone. Please pray that they will take the opportunity to hear the gospel in their heart language and respond to Jesus' invitation to follow Him. [Romans 10:17](#)

Tuesday 8 September

The Good Shepherd Project is one of Feba UK's newest partners and is also relatively new to the West African country where it serves (*the country cannot be named for security reasons*). Please pray that its application to become a registered charity will be approved. Although this can be a lengthy process, official registration is vital to enable the organisation to operate fully and effectively in the country. [Psalm 90:17](#)

Wednesday 9 September

Please pray for more volunteers to step forward and support the ministry in a number of key areas. In particular, ask God to raise up wise and discerning Christians to help with the follow-up ministry among listeners. [2 Timothy 2:2](#)

Thursday 10 September

The project has two evangelists who currently provide follow-up support and build relationships with listeners. Please pray for God's guidance as they seek His direction about whether to move to the region to strengthen the ministry. Pray that the Lord will give them peace, clarity and confirmation if this is where He is calling them to serve.

Friday 11 September

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One of the evangelists regularly travels to a village where he has established a small base for his ministry. Please pray for his safety, especially as security is a major concern when travelling outside the towns in this region. May the Lord open the hearts and minds of the many local people who come to visit him. [Psalm 121:7-8](#)

Saturday 12 September

Please pray for all those who listen to the radio broadcasts. The team is aware that only a very small proportion of listeners feel confident enough to call and express their appreciation for the programmes. Pray that listeners would not only hear God's word but respond by putting their faith and trust in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour. [John 5:24](#)

Sunday 13 September

As we conclude this week of prayer, please ask God to open the way for *The Good Shepherd Project* to secure a regular broadcast slot on the national radio station that reaches listeners across the whole country. May this exciting opportunity provide many more people with the chance to hear the good news of Jesus in their own heart language.

14 – 20 September: Vietnam

In this communist country where religious activity is closely monitored, ministry requires great wisdom and sensitivity. Feba's partner, *Vietnam Audio Bible Project*, is helping to reach ethnic minority people groups who learn orally, have limited literacy and often do not have access to the scriptures in their heart languages. Many listeners are discovering hope through God's word, while work continues to make the Bible available in every heart language across Vietnam.

Monday 14 September

ANSWERED PRAYER! Praise God for the ways He continues to open doors for the gospel despite the restrictions placed on believers in Vietnam. We also thank God for the progress being made in making the scriptures available in several heart languages among the country's 54 people groups. Please pray that many more people will soon be able to hear and understand God's word in their own heart language. [Romans 15:4](#)

Tuesday 15 September

Many listeners who hear Christian programmes have questions and are seeking help and encouragement as they grow as disciples of Jesus. Please pray for wisdom and opportunities for the follow-up teams and local believers to connect listeners with mature Christians and Bible-teaching churches where they can find fellowship and support.

Wednesday 16 September

Please remember the young people of Vietnam who are searching for identity, meaning and purpose in a rapidly changing society. Pray that the seeds being sown through Christian media will bear fruit, leading many young people to put their faith in Jesus and discover the truth of God's word. [Psalm 71:5](#)

Thursday 17 September

We give thanks for the staff and volunteers who dedicate many hours each month to the *Vietnam Audio Bible Project*. Pray that each person will be filled with God's Spirit and empowered with His wisdom and creativity. May the team keep their eyes fixed on Jesus as they carry out the many responsibilities involved in this ministry. [Hebrews 12:1-3](#)

Friday 18 September

The project depends on having reliable, up-to-date equipment and people with the wisdom and technical skills to develop affordable tools that enable others to hear and engage with the Bible. Pray that, as technology continues to evolve, the team will find creative ways to make Bible-based resources available to more people that are easy to use and understand. [James 1:5](#)

Saturday 19 September

Many families in Vietnam are facing economic pressures, the challenges of migration and the impact of natural disasters, including severe storms and flooding. Please pray that the Christian community will demonstrate Christ's compassion and bring hope to those experiencing hardship and loss. [Matthew 5:14-16](#)

Sunday 20 September

Please pray that the *Vietnam Audio Bible Project* will have a lasting impact not only on the lives of individual listeners, but also on their families, churches and communities. Ask God to use this ministry to raise up disciples, pastors, teachers and local leaders who will faithfully teach His word, strengthen local churches and share the gospel in communities where Jesus is not yet known. 21 – 30 September: Ukraine

In the midst of a war that shows no sign of ending, FEBC Ukraine continues to broadcast the gospel across the country. Through FM radio, social media, smartphone apps and web streaming, the team faithfully shares God's word and prays with people over the airwaves. They also offer practical support and comfort to listeners living with the trauma and disruption of this devastating conflict.

Monday 21 September

ANSWERED PRAYER! Praise God that a team of brave volunteers has successfully restored FM broadcasts in the Donetsk region and parts of the Luhansk region. Despite ongoing Russian drone attacks and constant shelling, they were able to install the antenna and bring the station back on air. We rejoice that people in this troubled region can once again hear FEBC Ukraine programmes on FM radio. Please pray for God's continued protection of the volunteers and His blessing on this vital ministry. [Psalm 91:11](#)

Tuesday 22 September

Please pray for the safety of every member of the team working for FEBC Ukraine. In recent weeks, Kyiv and many other Ukrainian cities have come under frequent, nightly attacks by Russian ballistic missiles. Pray for God's protection over the team, their families, the studios and broadcasting equipment. [Psalm 4:8](#)

Wednesday 23 September

We lift up in prayer radio host Andrii as he mourns the loss of his brother, who was killed on the front line. Ask the Lord to comfort and strengthen Andrii and his family, surround them with His loving presence and sustain them through this time of grief. [Psalm 34:18](#)

Thursday 24 September

We thank God for the courage and commitment of team members serving in the Armed Forces as chaplains and soldiers. Please pray for God's protection over them. May they be a light to those serving alongside them, sharing the good news of Jesus in places where hope is desperately needed. Praise God that many listeners in the military are contacting the team, particularly during the morning show. Pray that they will open their hearts to God and receive Jesus as their Lord and Saviour. [Isaiah 60:1-2](#)

Friday 25 September

Please pray for members of the FEBC Ukraine team and their loved ones who need healing. We lift up Iryna's father-in-law, who is battling cancer, and Eduard's son, Mark, who is recovering from surgery following a serious car accident. We thank God for protecting the lives of all those involved in the accident and pray for Mark's full recovery and renewed strength. [Psalm 41:3](#)

Saturday 26 September

Olena recently found FEBC Ukraine's HelpLine while searching online for suicide prevention. After talking and praying with the team, and hearing the hope of the gospel, Olena said that her suicidal thoughts had gone. Please pray for Olena and for everyone who contacts the HelpLine, that they would encounter God's comfort, healing and salvation. Please also pray for the follow-up workers who carry the emotional weight of these difficult conversations while living through the hardships of war themselves. [Psalm 40:1-3](#)

Sunday 27 September

This autumn, the team plans to continue hosting gatherings for Christian content creators and influencers. Please pray particularly for an online event designed to encourage and equip believers to share the gospel effectively through social media. Pray that those taking part will find creative ways to use their online platforms to share their faith and help more people discover the good news of Jesus. [Psalm 96:3](#)

Monday 28 September

ANSWERED PRAYER! We thank God for the *Embrace* gatherings, which support the families of Ukrainians serving in the Armed Forces. Most people who attend for the first time are not churchgoers. However, after just one meeting, many become open to hearing the gospel and are even willing to visit a local church. Please pray that everyone who attends *Embrace* will open their hearts to Christ and become part of a local church community. [Matthew 11:28-30](#)

Tuesday 29 September

Please pray for the team as they prepare for winter and the possibility of further Russian attacks on the country's critical infrastructure, which could lead to prolonged power cuts. Ask God to provide the equipment, backup power and other resources they need to keep broadcasting and sharing the hope of the gospel across Ukraine. [Philippians 4:19](#)

Wednesday 30 September

ANSWERED PRAYER! When Daniela first joined FEBC Ukraine's live broadcasts, she saw no point in believing in God. She insisted that prayer didn't work and that the Bible was simply an historical book that she could not understand. Yet Daniela kept returning, asking questions and talking with the team. Today, she begins each day with prayer, reads the Bible daily and is actively involved in her local church. Praise God for the transformation in Daniela's life and pray that many more listeners will open their hearts to the gospel and discover a life-changing relationship with Jesus Christ.
